YHWH'S APPOINTMENTS

Last week we looked at the commandment to keep YHWH's appointment concerning Shavuot (Lev 23:15-22).



We looked at the events that led our Jewish brethren to establish a different approach to Shavuot by incorporating the Giving of the Law (not receiving the law—we are constantly receiving the law) at Mt. Sinai instead of the Scriptural agricultural aspect of Shavuot.

Remember the counting of the Omer? 7 weeks and the day following would be the established appointment of YHWH.

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During the counting (during time of Yahshua's resurrection) Yahshua appeared to many to show that He indeed is the Messiah. He then left earth 10 days before Shavuot. He tells His followers to 'wait' until...

Today's Christian view on the Giving of the Ruach HaKodesh (Holy Spirit)

Most held view of Christianity today is that as a result of Acts 2 that the Holy Spirit is now living in those who have accepted Yahshua as their Savior, Redeemer and Lord.

This, they say, is when YHWH chose to dwell with man and in man. To live inside him.

Romans 8:7-9

because the mind of the flesh is enmity towards Elohim; for it is not subject to the Torah of Elohim, for it is not possible to be so. And those being in the flesh are not able to please Elohim. But you are not in flesh, but in Spirit, since the Spirit of YAHWEH dwells in you. But if anyone has not the Spirit of Messiah, this one does not belong to Him.

John 14:16-17

And I will petition the Father, and He will give you another one which will end the curse, that He may remain with you forever, the Spirit of Truth, whom the world cannot receive because it does not see Him nor know Him. But you know Him, for it dwells with you and shall be in you.



It is here in Acts chapter 2 and the pouring out of the Ruach HaKodesh that a vast majority of believers today give account that the Holy Spirit lives inside of the redeemed. This is when, they say, that we were given the Holy Spirit...
