




Topic: "YHWH's Appointments" Pt 29

YHWH'S APPOINTMENTS



In examining Shavuot a bit more closely we see that contextually there is more to approaching this wonderful feast of YHWH.

In preparation for Shavuot is the counting of the Omer, 50 days from FirstFruits. Also the time between Yahshua's resurrection and an out pouring of YHWH's Spirit. This was the promise given by the Father and the gift presented by Yahshua.

We learned last week that the premise of Shavuot was being a kingdom people. We also learned what YHWH expected of His people, how they were to be kingdom people and what that looked like.

Here we are at Shavuot and a miraculous appearance of YHWH's promise is poured out.

Some interesting notes concerning this out pouring before we start looking at the work of the Ruach HaKodesh (Holy Spirit).



Acts 2:1-44

The day of Shavuot gathered together (vs 1)

They were of the same mindset (vs 1)

Sudden outburst of sound likened to a mighty rushing wind (vs 2)

It came from out of heaven (vs 2)

The sound filled the place they were gathered (vs 2)

The sound caused people to come and listen (vs 6)

Tongues as of fire appeared and sat on each of them (vs 3)

It appears that this happened only to those that were in the same place (vs 1)

vs 6 sees those who heard the sound and were drawn to know what it was

All filled (referring again to those that were gathered vs 1) with the Ruach word filled here is pletho in the Greek. Meaning to imbue, influence, supply, accomplish, fill as to being full come or furnish. Imbue's definition is:

im'byoo/
verb

verb: **imbue**; 3rd person present: **imbues**; past tense: **imbued**; past participle: **imbued**; gerund or present participle: **imbuing**

1 inspire or permeate with a feeling or quality.

They began to speak (give testimony vs 4)

They spoke in languages that others could understand (vs 6)

They spoke as they were guided by the Ruach HaKodesh (vs 4)
