YHWH'S APPOINTMENTS

Deut 32:4 "He is the Rock; His work is perfect. For all His ways are just, an El of faithfulness, and without evil; just and upright is He."



Yom Kippur is a day of Atonement. A day of judgment and placement.

Are you in good standing with your Creator or bad standing?

We need to understand that YHWH's character demands righteousness, it demands holiness, it demands justice.

Of Messiah (the perfect reflection of His Father) we see He rules with a scepter of justice.
 Ps 45:6 "Your throne, O Elohim, is forever and ever; the scepter of Your kingdom is a scepter of uprightness."

The Father has entrusted all judgment to His Son.

John 5:22, 23 "For the Father judges no one, but has given all judgment to the Son, 5:23 so that all may honor the Son, even as they honor the Father³³. The one not honoring the Son does not honor the Father who has sent Him."



Yahshua alone is worthy to open the scroll of Revelation 5:5

What is the God pattern we see in YHWH concerning His judgment?

The judgment of Adam and Eve (Gen 3:14-24)

This judgment affected all of creation (Gen 3:17-18; Rm 8:20-22)

The judgment of the antediluvian world (Gen 7:17-24) [pre-flood]

The judgment at the Tower of Babel (Gen 11:5-9)

The judgment of Egypt and their gods (Ex 7-12)

The judgment of Believer's (Isaiah 53:4-8)

The judgment of the world (the system) and ha satan (Jn 12:31)

Self-evaluation



1 Cor 11:28, 29 "But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread, and let him drink of the cup; for he eating and drinking unworthily eats and drinks to his condemnation, not discerning the body of Master YAHWEH."

[the idea of anah yourself at Yom Kippur]

With idea of being more like Messiah (at-one-with)

Eph 4:21-24 "If indeed you heard Him and were taught in Him as the truth is in Yahshua. Lay aside all your former practices and put off the old man, having been degenerated with deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and to put on the new man, who is created by YAHWEH in righteousness and true holiness."



Church discipline

Mt 18:15-17 "And if your brother with you is at fault, go rebuke him, between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won your brother. But if he does not hear, take one or two more with you, "so that on the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established." But if he fails to hear them, tell it to the congregation. And if he also fails to hear the congregation, let him be to you as a tax collector and a heathen."

Divine discipline

Heb 12:5-11 "And you have forgotten the exhortation which He speaks with you, as with sons, "My sons, do not despise the chastening of YAHWEH, nor faint while being corrected by Him. For whom YAHWEH loves, He chastens, and disciplines every son with whom He is pleased." If you endure discipline, YAHWEH is dealing with you as with sons; for who is the son whom a father does not discipline? But if you are without discipline, of which all have become sharers, then you are strangers, and not sons. Furthermore, indeed we have had fathers of our flesh as correctors, and we respected them. Shall we not much more be subject to the Father of spirits, and we shall live? For they truly disciplined us for a few days according to the thing seeming good to them; but He for our profit, in order for us to partake of His holiness. And all discipline for the present indeed does not seem to be joyous, but grievous; but afterward it gives back peaceable fruit of righteousness to the ones having been exercised by it."

When we are judged in this way it is so we won't be condemned with the world (1 For 11:32)

Messiah chastens (disciplines) those He loves (Revelation 3:19)

Future Judgment: The final judgment

note: this does not include the judgments during the tribulation period. The seals, the trumpets and the bowls. This does not include the judging of the nations.

Rev 20:11-15 Known as the "Great White Throne Judgment"

2 Stages:



1. The separation of "goats and sheep" (Mat 25:31-46)
This links with Isaiah 43. Our position with Messiah.
2. Believer's works judged (judgment of our works. How we behave. These are what

we keep in check each year as we engage in Yom Kippur. The anah of oneself)
(2 Cor 5:10; 1 Cor 3:12; Rev 3:11; Heb 6:10)

We have been separated as His people, then judged on our works, behaviors, obedience to YHWH's instructions (Torah).

Job 8:3 (Bildad) "Or does The El pervert judgment? Or does the Almighty pervert the right?"

Deut 32:4 "He is the Rock; His work is perfect. For all His ways are just, an El of faithfulness, and without evil; just and upright is He."
