




Topic: "YHWH's Dietary Instructions" Pt 11

Scriptural Dietary Instructions



Shaul (Paul)

2 Peter 3:15-18 And consider the long-suffering of YAHWEH to be our redemption, as also our beloved brother Paul wrote to you, according to the wisdom given to him; as also in all his epistles, speaking in them concerning these things, in which some things are hard to understand, which those that are ignorant and unstable pervert their meaning, as also they do the rest of the Scriptures, to their own destruction. Therefore beloved, since you know these things beforehand, guard yourself, lest being led away by the error of

the lawless you fall from your own steadfastness. But grow in grace and knowledge of our Master and Savior, Yahshua Messiah and of YAHWEH the Father. To Him be the glory, both now and to the days of eternity. Amen.

Romans 1:1-5 Paul, a slave of Yahshua Messiah, a called apostle, set apart to the good news of Elohim, which He promised before through His prophets in the Holy Scriptures, concerning His Son who came of the seed of David according to flesh, who was made known as the Son of Elohim in power, according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection of the dead, Yahshua Messiah our Master; by whom we received grace and apostleship to obedience of faith among all the nations, for His name's sake,

Acts 28:16-18, 23 And when we went into Rome, the centurion delivered the prisoners to the camp commander. But Paul was allowed to remain by himself, with the soldier guarding him. And after three days, Paul sent and called for the principal Jews. And when they were assembled, he said to them: Men, my brethren, although I did nothing against the people or the law of my fathers, I was at Jerusalem delivered over in bonds to the Romans: Who examining me were of a mind to let me go, because no cause of death was in me....(vs 23) And having appointed him a day, more came to him in the lodging, to whom he expounded, earnestly testifying the kingdom of YAHWEH and persuading them the things concerning Yahshua, both from the Torah of Moses and the Prophets, from morning until evening.

Acts 28:24-27 And some indeed were persuaded by that being said, others disbelieved. And they went out from him, disagreeing among themselves. And Paul addressed to them this speech: Well did the Holy Spirit speak through the prophet Isaiah to our fathers, saying, "Go to this people and say, You will surely hear, and not at all understand; and you will surely see, and not at all perceive; for the heart of this people was fattened, and they have heard with the ears heavily; and they closed their eyes lest at any time they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and be converted, and I should heal them." (Isa. 6:9, 10)

- vs 3 ANY man love YHWH...he is known by (of, in, under, with, among???) Him



5259. ὑπό hupo, hoop-o´; a primary preposition; under, i.e. (with the genitive case) of place (beneath), or with verbs (the agency or means, through); (with the accusative case) of place (whither (underneath) or where (below) or time (when (at))): — among, by, from, in, of, under, with. In the comparative, it retains the same general applications, especially of inferior position or condition, and specially, covertly or moderately.

Which one? What is being said here? Does Elohim recognize him because he loves Elohim? Or do others recognize he loves Elohim by how he conducts his behavior? What does the text most suggest? What defines how man is to love Elohim?

- vs 4 Coming back to the original topic...more defined...eating foods offered to idols. We know that idols are nothing...Only one true Elohim

vs 5 Though others may believe in other gods...and people do



vs 6 But to US (those who believe in YHWH and His Anointed One, Yahshua) there is only One El. We know idols are lifeless statues.

vs 7 Not everyone gets this. They eat in respect and recognition to that idol. They do as the children of Israel did at Mt. Sinai, they worship an idol and YHWH

at the same time.

vs 8 Meat does not bring you close to YHWH the most high.

Romans 14:23 If you aren't sure you should eat it, don't eat it. To do so is a sin.

James 1:8 A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.
