




Topic: "YHWH's Dietary Instructions" Pt 13
Scripture: 1 Cor 10:19-31
Definition: "Foods Sacrificed to Idols" pt 3

Scriptural Dietary Instructions



Shaul (Paul)

1 Corinthians 9:1, 2 Am I not an apostle? Am I not free? Have I not seen our Master Yahshua Messiah? Are you not my work in our Master? If I am not an apostle to others, yet I am indeed to you; for you are the seal of my apostleship in the Master.

1 Corinthians 9:8 Do I speak these things according to man, or does not the Torah say these things also?

1 Corinthians 9:24-27 Shaul continues to assess character building.

Let's turn to 1 Corinthians 10:19-31...



vs 19 Is the idol anything? NO its wood, stone, clay, glass, an inanimate object.

vs 20 They are not to have fellowship with the demons. (Deut 32:17)

(Note: Very important to catch this aspect of what Shaul is teaching us. Here he addresses two of the 5 instructions of Acts 15 council's recommendations. We see it more clearly in John's revelation...

Revelation 2:20-21 But I have a few things against you, that you allow the woman Jezebel to teach, she saying herself to be a prophetess, and to cause My servants to go astray, and to commit fornication, and to eat idol sacrifices. And I gave time to her that she might repent of her fornication. And she did not repent.)

vs 21 The idea of fellowshiping with the demons. You cannot serve Elohim and any other. Remember Mt. Sinai.

vs 22 Again I remind you, from Scripture itself...whose more important? You or YHWH?

vs 23 All things...in context, not the entirety of the Instructions (Law, Torah) but all things pertaining to the instructions concerning this topic!
Just because I can do something, doesn't mean I should.

vs 24 You should be concerned with your brothers more than yourselves.

vs 25 When you purchase food (YHWH's definition of food, not ours, not western thought of food, not another countries definition, but YHWH's) you are free to eat it.

vs 26 Why? because all the food in the market belongs to YHWH. He made them.
vs 27 Dinning with the lost, eat what is put before you (again I remind you its speaking of food (defined by YHWH and revealed earlier in I Cor 8:4)...Don't ask if it was offered to an idol.



vs 28 If an unbeliever tells you on his own that the food is offered to an idol...Don't eat it. Logically defining that if we cannot eat food from food offered to an idol, how much more can we not eat something that isn't defined as food by YHWH???

vs 29 Not of your conscience, but for the sake of the other person
Romans 14:13-23 Don't become a stumbling block.

vs 30 Why then should I be judged for eating food (YHWH's food)? I shouldn't...but

vs 31 Whatever you do...do for the glory of YHWH your Elohim.

“A Time and Place for Everything”

Don't allow your liberty to cause a brother or sister to fall. This is what Shaul is teaching and it lines up with the Torah and the Revelation by YHWH given to John.
