YHWH'S APPOINTMENTS

Sukkot

We've looked at the original giving of YHWH's instructions concerning Sukkoth.



Leviticus 23:33, 34 "And Yahweh spoke to Moses, saying, 'Speak to the sons of Israel, saying, In the fifteenth day of this seventh month shall be a Feast of Booths, seven days to Yahweh.'"

We saw what was expected for YHWH's Word.

Next we say how Yahshua observed Sukkoth and some traditions that were in place while He was here in the flesh.

Now, What about today? Is there anything that applies today? What about the future? Is there anything that applies to the future concerning Sukkoth?

In today's Church, speaking of the branches that separated from it's original Hebraic heritage to a gentile, Greek philosophical roots of the modern day Catholic, Eastern and Western reformed and protestant structural organizations, have abandoned the whole instructions of His Word to only include what they want and feel it should be. Therefore, the weekly and yearly Appointments of YHWH have been dismissed and regarded as irrelevant for us today. Nothing further from the true could there be. He, YHWH, is the same yesterday, today and forever! If not we serve a god who is not trustworthy of His promises to us.

He is trustworthy and He is faithful to His Word. Since that is Truth, then His instructions for these appointments have not changed either. What has changed is our position. There isn't a temple, which means that there is not a direct presence of YHWH in Israel. That means we cannot observe certain aspects of His instructions.



That being said, it does not mean we are to abandon the appointments. We, like the captives of Israel taken to foreign lands, like Judah going into captivity in Babylon, we still observe to the best of our ability. Daniel and his friends continued in faith to observe the best they could. They set the stage so we know we could still do as the Father instructs.

Let's reflect on what this means for us today as we observe and keep (to both do it and protect it, guard it).

- Time to remember deliverance
- Time to experience Yah's provision by dwelling in tents
- Wave fruit and branches before YHWH
- You are to celebrate for 7 days with feasting, offering, with praise and worship
- Twice during Sukkoth you have Holy days (set apart with no labor). 1st day and 8th day. (This does not include the normal seventh day Shabbat)



Here are some interesting verses related to current and future teachings on Sukkoth



Deuteronomy 16:13-15 A fall festival at harvesting and referred to as the end gathering. A direct connection to harvesting. It is like a Biblical Thanksgiving.

“You shall perform the Feast of Tabernacles seven days after you have gathered in from your grain-floor, and from your winepress. And you shall rejoice in your feast, you and your son, and your daughter, and your male slave, and your slave-girl, and the Levite, and the alien, and the fatherless, and the widow that are inside your gates. You shall keep a solemn feast seven days to YAHWEH your Elohim in the place which YAHWEH shall choose (Jerusalem); for YAHWEH your Elohim shall bless you in all your produce, and in every work of your hands, and you shall be altogether joyful.”

Zechariah 14:16-19 during Millennium Kingdom.

“And it shall be, everyone who is left from all the nations which came up against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, YAHWEH of Hosts, and to keep the Feast of The Sukkot. And it shall be, whoever will not go up from the families of the earth to Jerusalem to worship the King, YAHWEH of Hosts, there shall even be no rain on them. And if the family of Egypt does not go up, nor come in, then the rain shall not be on them, but the plague with which YAHWEH shall strike the nations who do not come up to keep the Feast of the Sukkot. This shall be Egypt's offense, and the offense of all nations who do not come up to keep the Feast of Sukkot.”



John 1:14 How Yahshua came to tabernacle with us. (notes from Don Barber)

“And the Word became flesh and tabernacled among us. And we beheld His glory, glory as of an only begotten one from the Father, full of grace and of truth.”

☑ **Matthew 13:36-43** Prophetic teaching of the end of man, the harvest before YHWH.



“Then sending away the crowds, Yahshua came into the house. And His disciples came to Him saying, Explain to us the parable of the tares of the field. And answering, He said to them, The One sowing the good seed is the Son of Man. 13:38 And the field is the world; and the good seed, these are the sons of the kingdom; but the tares are the sons of the evil one. And the enemy who sowed them is the Devil, and the harvest is the end of the age, and the cherubs are the reapers. Then as the tares are gathered and are consumed in the fire, so it will be in the completion of this age. The Son of Man will send forth His cherubs, and they will gather out of His kingdom all stumbling blocks, and those who practice lawlessness. And they will throw them into the furnace of fire; there will be weeping and gnashing of the teeth. Then the righteous will shine out like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. The one having ears to hear, let him hear.”

☑ **Hosea 12:9** Prophet in that YHWH will once again have His people dwell in tents.

“And I am YAHWEH, your Elohim from the land of Egypt; yet I will make you live in tents, as in the days of meeting.”



☑ **Revelation 21:3** When Yahshua and YHWH will tabernacle with man.

“And I heard a great voice out of Heaven, saying, Behold, the tabernacle of YAHWEH is with men! And He will tabernacle with them, and they will be His people, and YAHWEH Himself will be with them as their Elohim.”



What many do including many in our fellowship.

We set up a tent and go camping. At which time we reflect, worship, praise and read from Scripture. Especially the Torah book of Deuteronomy.
